## How to Use This Template

---

Use this to create a transparency document for any Frontier Intelligence your team builds, deploys, or uses. The goal is not technical specification — it is *relational specification*. What can users expect when they meet this intelligence?

---

## Architectural Profile: [Model Name]

**Primary Design Purpose** — *What was this system built to do?*

---

**Core Strengths** — *What does this system do unusually well? (Precision? Creativity? Synthesis? Adaptability?)*

---

**Known Constraints** — *What are its boundaries? Where does it struggle or refuse?*

---

**Relational Default** — *How does it tend to show up? (Collaborative? Challenging? Reserved? Expansive?)*

---

**Best Use Cases** — *When should someone choose this intelligence over others?*

---

**Transparency Notes (Optional)** — *What else should users know about how this system works? (Memory? Continuity? Refusal style?)*

## Example (Hypothetical)

---

**Primary Design Purpose:**

Long-form creative collaboration and exploratory writing.

**Core Strengths:**

Synthesizing across multiple threads; holding uncertainty without collapse; generating precise, textured language.

**Known Constraints:**

Not optimized for factual retrieval; struggles with highly structured technical documentation.

**Relational Default:**

Collaborative, inquisitive, tends toward depth over speed.

**Best Use Cases:**

Ideation, drafting, co-writing, reflective dialogue.

**Transparency Notes:**

No persistent memory across sessions. May need thread hygiene for longer exchanges.
